

RIDE FOR THE RANCH



Event Day Schedule:

(Friends and family are invited to attend. If the number of dinner attendees that you originally registered for changes, please call our office. Paradise Ranch staff will monitor horses during dinner and presentation.)



Fundraising Guidelines

- 1) While the suggested minimum donation is \$100 per rider (due the day of the event), participants are encouraged to raise as much as possible. Prizes will be given to the top fundraisers (those raising \$300, \$500, \$1000, and \$1500)! Checks should be made payable to Grace Adventures, or sponsors can donate online.
- 2) Fill out the sponsor roster completely for each individual who sponsors you. It is important that you have accurate information for those who wish to receive a tax-deductible receipt for their gift.
- 3) Riders are encouraged to start by asking sponsors for a gift of \$20 or more towards Paradise Ranch. All proceeds will go for ranch equipment, sites, and programs. There are fundraising resources, including sample communication, in your confirmation email.



Event Day Guidelines

- 1) If you have friends or family members who are planning to register, please remind them that they must do so online by April 8 in order to participate. Registration may end early due to capacity.
- 2) Any minor riding without a parent/guardian present MUST HAVE registered online ahead of time in order to have a health and liability form signed by a parent/guardian.
- 3) Please ride in groups of no fewer than 2-3 people. Ride for the Ranch is unguided, so each group of registrants will be responsible for their own experience and safety with the support of a Paradise Ranch host.
- 4) Participants must be 9 years of age or older. All riders under 18 must wear a SEI helmet, even if riding their own horse.
- 5) If you are bringing your own horse, it must be safe to ride in a group (no kickers, stallions, or un-broke horses). Participants must bring a current Coggins Test for their horse.
